#### Public Law Children

Emma is regularly led by King's Counsel in particularly complex cases.

- Re AB (Children) (Care & Placement Orders) [2021] EWFC B34 (23 April 2021)
  Applications for care and placement orders. The care plan was for the children to be placed together by way of adoption.

Emma has a strong private law practice. She is regularly instructed in matters involving parental alienation, alcohol and substance abuse, mental health issues, sexual and other domestic abuse, and internal relocation.
